On this basis, in a continuous education system, the first teacher in elementary schools is considered a great God for young people and is the default for children. Therefore, the creativity, mobility, understanding of children, communication and pertseptive abilities of primary school teachers will be an important factor. This is because mobility, curiosity, and a strong appetite for knowledge in elementary school students are scientifically based on psychologists. Only such interests and passions are required to be directed positively. This requires even more research,



creativity and freshness from elementary school teachers. The issue of creative work of teachers has been studied scientifically by pedagogical scientists, including the creativity of elementary school teachers, one of the main issues. Including creativity, this is an important pedagogical problem, and research in this regard is a requirement today.

In the context of modern globalization and information technology of education, the creative work of the future primary school teacher will be of great importance. - 2. Creativity is an integration of the teacher's professional and personal quality. Because without natural curiosity and eagerness, the teacher will never be able to demonstrate creativity.
- 3. Creativity is not a self-emerging quality in teachers, it is related to a teacher's desire for innovation, overcome the difficulties faced in the process of mastering innovation and being able to apply it in his or her pedagogical hierarchy, actively, creatively using innovative innovations in his or her hierarchy, and finding solutions (Christian) to his or her copyright ideas.
- 4. The formation of the creativity of a prospective elementary school teacher stems from "needs, directions and "I" concepts. It is a time-consuming process for a primary school teacher to demonstrate his creative activities in all types of pedagogical activities. We can conclude that the teacher's creative work is primarily related to pedagogical skills.

Modern science opportunities in a continuous education system do not have the opportunity to explain the nature of creativity as a universal explanation that fully satisfies existing evidence and questions. In this case:

- **1.** Creativity is the foundation of a person's qualities throughout his life.
- **2.** Creativity is a way of accomplishing certain tasks and tasks entrusted to a person.
- **3.** Creativity is the product of intellect.
- **4.** Creativity is the ability, discoveries, given to a person by God.
- **5.** Creativity is a creative activity.
- **6.** Creativity is the moral, ethical and social adaptation of creative people.
- 7. Creativity is a category that is incompatible with culture.

3. The criterion for oral creativity is determined by the following indicators: originality, niversal, productivity.

Because the organization of teachers at a higher level is not a spontaneous situation, but the future teacher's research, ability to apply innovations in their experiences, and encourage students to "read" rather than "teach".
